As Regional Minister for Global Missions, Doug has been inviting churches in our region to connect with American Baptist Missionaries through visits to churches and having missionaries present their ministries at regional gatherings. Doug has facilitated several mission trips including many years of serving in Mexico and taking groups to South Africa, Poland, Thailand, Arizona and in Los Angeles. He has also served our churches by providing pulpit supply and helping churches in ministry effectiveness. During his time with the region he has facilitated many opportunities to equip those serving in pastoral and lay ministry including the Pastoral Covenant Groups, Equip Conference, Mission Advocates Training Events, and helping plan the equipping components of Annual Meetings.
